Postal Vote

Eligible for a postal vote are:

1. All European citizens enrolled on the electoral lists and aged at least 18 on Election Day;
2. All Luxembourg citizens living abroad.

An application should be made either by simple letter, by pre-printed form or via the website www.myguichet.lu.

It should be sent to the Mayor and College of Aldermen for the municipality of residence.

An application by a Luxembourg citizen living abroad should be sent to the municipality of the last domicile in the Grand Duchy, or failing that, to the municipality of birth in the Grand Duchy or to the City of Luxembourg. The applicant must produce a copy of a valid Luxembourg passport or Luxembourg identity card.

Deadlines

If the voting form is sent to an address in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg:

The application must reach the Mayor and College of Aldermen, under pain of forfeiture, no earlier than Monday 4th March 2019 and at the latest on Wednesday, 1st May 2019.

If the voting form is sent to an address abroad:

The application must reach the Mayor and College of Aldermen, under pain of forfeiture, no earlier than Monday 4th March 2019 and at the latest on Tuesday, 16th April 2019.
